I forward herewith a copy of the proposal received vide reference cited and to inform that, this Government has 'No Objection', for the affiliation of CBSE, New Delhi, to be granted for Classes from PP to VIII to Kshatriya School, Chepur (V), Armoor(M), Nizamabad District, from the Academic Year 2022-2023, subject to the following conditions: -

- The Educational agency shall submit the Annual Administration Report in the prescribed proforma as prescribed in G.O.Ms.No.1 Education, dated 01.01.1994, to the competent authority for every financial year by 30th of September at the latest. Such Report shall be supported by the audited statement of accounts of the school duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- The School Management shall upload their school information in the web site of the State School Education department including their fees details and other required information useful to the parents.
- The Management should follow the provisions of the Telangana Education Act, 1982; G.O.Ms.No.1, Education (PS.2) Department, dt.01.01.1994, as amended from time to time and Compulsory Teaching and Learning of Telugu as per the provisions of the Act No.10 of 2018, dt.30.03.2018, which came into force from 02.04.2018 and the connected Rules to this Act issued vide G.O.Ms.No.15, School Education (Prog.II) Department, dt:01.06.2018. The Government have also prescribed the books to be introduced for Classes I and VI which have to be followed for the Compulsory Teaching & Learning of Telugu language as per this Act 10 of 2018 & the connected Rules.
- The Educational Agency & School Management shall follow instructions issued in G.O.Ms.No.36, School Education(Genl.)Dept., dated 16.12.2017 to ensure the safety and security of the children in the school and shall also comply with all acts/guidelines/instructions as and when they are issued by the Government from time to time.
